WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE?

This document tells you how the Fisher Funds CashPlus Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Fisher Funds Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

DESCRIPTION OF THIS FUND

The fund aims to provide stable returns and reduce the potential of capital loss over the short to medium term by investing in New Zealand cash and New Zealand short term fixed interest assets.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF INVESTING?

The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.



HOW HAS THE FUND PERFORMED?

WHAT FEES ARE INVESTORS CHARGED?

Investors in the CashPlus Fund are charged fund charges that include GST. In the year to 31 March 2021 these were:

EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$18 (that is 0.18% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah did not pay other charges. This gives Sarah a total return after tax of \$18 for the year.


Actual investment mix
