WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE?

This document tells you how the Fisher Funds New Zealand Fixed Income Trust has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Fisher Funds Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

DESCRIPTION OF THIS FUND

The fund aims provide protection for your investment while also generating a stable level of return over the long term by investing in New Zealand fixed interest assets.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF INVESTING?

The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.



HOW HAS THE FUND PERFORMED?

ANNUAL RETURN GRAPH



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 30 September 2019.

WHAT FEES ARE INVESTORS CHARGED?

Investors in the New Zealand Fixed Income Trust are charged fund charges that include GST. In the year to 31 March 2019 these were:


EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$709 (that is 7.09% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah did not pay other charges. This gives Sarah a total return after tax of \$709 for the year.

NOTES

¹ On 1 July 2019 the market index changed to the Bloomberg New Zealand Bond Composite 0+ Year Index. While the S&P/NZX New Zealand Government Bond Index was an adequate benchmark, it was not entirely representative of the long-term asset mix of the fund. We view the composition of the Bloomberg New Zealand Bond Composite 0+ Year Index as more closely reflecting that of the fund over the long term, and more representative of the investible universe available to our investment team.
