What is the purpose of this update?



How has the fund performed?

Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each of the last 10 years ending 31 March. The last bar shows the average annual return for the last 10 years, up to 31 March 2018.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the Trans Tasman Equity Trust are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2017 these were:

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Example of how this applies to an investor

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,089 (that is 10.89% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah did not pay other charges. This gives Sarah a total return after tax of \$1,089 for the year.
